Recruitment of Grade II Dental Surgeon to the Department of Health Services

Applications are invited for recruitment of 106 Grade II Dental Surgeons to the Department of Health Services by the order of Secretary, Public Service Commission; from the candidates who are fulfilling the requirements as described in clause 04. The applications as per the specimen with the order of preferences according to the list of centers for three month training and list of vacancies will be accepted on **20th November 2015** from 9.00 am to 3.00pm at **the Auditorium of National Blood Transfusion Service, Elvitigala Road, Narahenpita, Colombo 05**. The staff members of office of the DDG /DS will examine your certificates and assist you to mark the preferences for Training Centers and Vacant Stations. 02. Annual Salary Scale: (As per Public Administration Circular 06/2006)

Rs: 25,515 - 645 x 4 - 650 x 10 - 1,050 x 3 – 37,745/=

(Should pass the Departmental Efficiency Bar exam before salary step of 27,450/=)

In addition to the above salary scale, allowances will be provided according to the provisions of government and departmental circulars.

03. The post is permanent and pensionable. Your appointment is subject to a probation period of three years from the date of appointment and will be governed by the orders of Public Service Commission, provisions of the Establishment Code, the Financial Regulations, Departmental Orders and any other regulations or rules issued from time to time by the government. You should pass the proficiency exam in the 2nd official language within 5 years or increments will be differed.

04. The merit of the candidates will be considered according to the following order of eligible Dental Surgeons.

a. Those who have graduated from Faculty of Dental Sciences, Peradeniya in year 2013 according to the merit list issued by the Faculty. (Edited after removing the names of the Dental Surgeons already recruited in 2014)

b. Any registered Dental Surgeon who applied for postponement of appointment and who have got approval of the Public Service Commission in corresponding years due to contractual commitment in employment, education or long term medical care according to the year of graduation (Names List of the relevant Dental Surgeons is published in the web site)

c. Dental Graduates from foreign Universities registered in SLMC during the year 2013 as per their date of registration.

d. If the vacancies cannot be filled with above candidates under (a), (b) and (c); applications of graduates who fulfill the requirements after 2013 will be considered according to their merit order in each year of graduation in descending order.

05. Recruitment will be done according to the merit order only.

06. Below mentioned documents should be included in all applications.

a. Duly signed applications with the preferences indicated on the formats.

b. Copy of Birth Certificate.

c. Copy of the Sri Lanka Medical Council registration certificate.

d. Copy of the National Identity Card

(Originals of such documents should be made available for verification on 20th November 2015.)

Merit list (for the 2013 batch), list of vacant stations, and the format for application can be downloaded from the web site www.health.gov.lk or can be obtained from the office of the Deputy Director General (Dental Services).

07. The Dental Surgeons who are appointed to Grade 11 should follow an introductory training programme approved by Director General of Health Services.

08. If you do not intend to apply for the posts of Dental Surgeon or need to postpone the appointment till next year, you should appeal before the closing date of appointments to get the approval from the Public Service Commission. Only the Dental Surgeons who has duly postponed their appointment and approved by Public Service Commission can apply for the posts of Dental Surgeon in future years.

09. In making preferences, applicants are advised to indicate number of preferences either equal to or more than his/her merit position to ensure an allocation of a station
