I am pleased to inform you that the Nursing Officers mentioned in the Annexure attached herewith, are being selected for Emergency Care Training programme for Nursing Officers. You are hereby informed to release all the Nursing Officers, selected for this training, as to avail for reporting to the Principal of the Post Basic School of Nursing, Colombo at 8.00 a.m. on **07<sup>th</sup> September 2015**.

The duration of this training programme is six months. The training programme is conducted in Post Basic Collage of Nursing, with attachment for practical training in NHSL, LRH and Colombo South Teaching hospital.

These officers will be released back to their original service stations after completion of six months training. Duty leave should be granted for these nursing officers in order to attend the training programme for 6 months. Certificate will be issued to the nursing officers, who will be successful in the examination conducted at the end of six months training.

These trained nursing officers should be attached compulsorily to the Emergency Care Unit for two years period. Before commencing of training programme, the each trainee has to sign an agreement with the Ministry of Health in this regard. The relevant agreements will be sent to them in due time.

The travelling and other allowances for these officers should be paid by the relevant Provincial Health Departments or by the institutions as per the Establishment Code and Financial Regulations.

If any nursing officer is unable to attend to this training on a reasonable ground, it should be informed to us through their Head of the Institution, before the commencement of training programme and next suitable officer from the same institution will be selected for this training by, Ministry of Health, according to their service seniority in ETU.

The selected officers for this training should arrange their residential facilities by themselves during this training period.
