- (r) Technical staffs of Anti Filariasis campaign design, plan, train, conduct entomological activities and research activities. In addition, it is important to see the possibilities of having an insectary at Anti Filariasis Campaign. Technical staffs of Regional Anti Filariasis Units are involved in training the regional staff and conducting programs in the regions. Therefore, it is necessary to observe and actively participate at a place where the training needs are fulfilled.

1. Age below 55 years at closing date of application
2. Confirmed in service with a minimum of 3 years in Anti Filariasis Campaign
3. Should not be a post graduate trainee at present
4. Having Post Graduate qualifications are added advantages.

(sk) **Selection Criteria for one Medical Officer of Regional Anti Filariasis Unit**

1. Age below 55 years at closing date of application
2. Confirmed in service with a minimum of 9 months in a Regional Anti Filariasis Unit
3. Should not be a post graduate trainee at present
4. Having Post Graduate qualifications are added advantages.

Selection Criteria for one Entomologist of Anti Filariasis Campaign

1. Age below 55 years at closing date of application
2. Confirmed in service with a minimum of 3 years in Anti Filariasis Campaign

Selection Criteria for two Entomological Assistants of Anti Filariasis Campaign or Regional Anti Filariasis Unit

1. Age below 55 years at closing date of application
2. Confirmed in service with a minimum of 9 months in Anti Filariasis Campaign or Regional Anti Filariasis Unit
3. Should have good command in written and spoken English

Selection will be done by an interview board. Selected candidates should be willing to work at Anti Filariasis Campaign or Regional Anti Filariasis Unit at least for 2 years after training and he or she should be able to train the other staff in relevant field as and when necessary. The candidate should be mentally and physically fit to undertake the training in a foreign country.
