Calling for Applications

Applications are called again for the following fellowship of WHO biennium 2014/2015. Please submit duly filled applications to Director, National Blood Centre No. 555/5D Elvitigala Mawatha Colombo 05 on or before 20th May 2015.

Travel for one Medical Officer and a Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT) on quality management of blood services in a regional country.

The reagent laboratory of National Blood Centre prepares reagent cells for reverse blood grouping and antibody screening, phosphate buffered saline, distilled water, copper sulphate solutions and certain anti-sera namely Anti-A1 and Anti-H.

It has been planned to expand the services of reagent preparation laboratory to produce more reagents including anti-sera and reagent red cells for antibody identification. In this process it is essential to maintain the quality standards of all reagents prepared in the laboratory.

Therefore, it is necessary to observe and actively participate in the reagent preparation process of a laboratory where all required quality standards are maintained.

Selection Criteria for Medical Officers

1. Age below 50 years at closing date of application
2. Confirmed in service with a minimum of 3 years blood bank experience
3. A Diploma / MD in Transfusion Medicine will be an added qualification
4. The Medical Officer should not be a PGIM trainee at present.

Selection Criteria for Medical Laboratory Technologists (MLTs)

1. Age below 50 years at closing date of application
2. Confirmed in service with a minimum of 3 years of blood bank experience
3. Should have good command in written and spoken English

Selection will be done by an interview board. Selected candidates should be willing to work at Reagent Lab of National Blood Centre at least for 3 years after training and he or she should be able to train the other staff in relevant field as and when necessary. The candidate should be mentally and physically fit to undertake the training in a foreign country.
