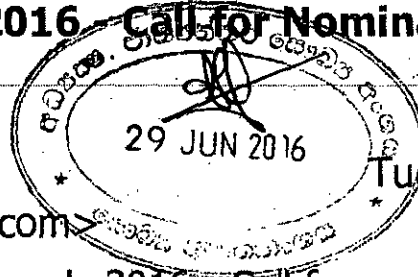

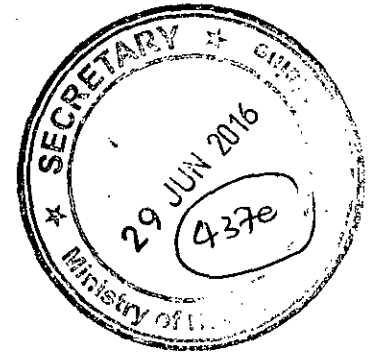

3. If you have supporting documents you would like to include with the nomination (such as a CV or a newspaper article), please also attach them to the emailed nomination.

### Terms and Conditions:

The N-Peace Awards 2016 is an independent, public, non-monetary award in recognition of local public service selected in agreement with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) herein referred to as the 'partner':

### The Nominators

- Any person may nominate candidates for any category of the N-Peace Award.
- It is the nominator's duty to inform the nominee of their nomination and associated terms before submitting their nomination.
- Nominators must provide all relevant and necessary information about the candidate - including adequate information for a biography and an image of the candidate - or the nomination may be rejected.
- Self-nominations are not accepted.

### The Partner

- The Partner is responsible for receiving the nominations, reviewing them, publishing them and overseeing the voting process.
- The Partner reserves the right to review all the nominations received and may refuse to publish nominations that are deemed to be incomplete, inaccurate or which may cause offense to others.
- The Partner is responsible for facilitating and overseeing the process of voting, but cannot be held responsible for the final results.

### The Process

- Nominators will not be allowed to withdraw their nominee from the process, once the voting has commenced.
- Nominations for an N-Peace Award will be accepted until 15 July, 2016.
- The partner will be monitoring the voting process and reserves the right to check, verify, and disqualify votes to any nominee total tallies where the source is not genuine.
- Seven women will be announced as winners for the Untold Stories category, one from each of the seven participating N-Peace Network countries. For Campaigning for Action and Peace Generation, one woman and

one man will be announced as winners.

- All winners will be invited to attend a special event held in Dec 2016 in association with UNDP. Details to be announced in due course.

### **Join N-Peace in supporting women's leadership for peace and social cohesion in Asia!**

*Please see below the criteria for this year's awards:*

#### **Criteria I.**

##### **Untold Stories – women transforming their communities (one from each country):**

*This award recognizes the efforts of women (over 30 years) who have demonstrated skills in conflict resolution, prevention and peace building in their communities. There will be seven winners in total for this category, one winner from each of the seven participating countries. This category focuses on sharing the stories of women who work at the grassroots level, who work tirelessly for change but get little to no recognition.*

#### Eligibility



- Women from the Philippines, Afghanistan, Indonesia, Nepal, Myanmar, Sri Lanka or Pakistan are eligible.
- Must be aged 30 years or older and must not have previously won an N-Peace Award.
- Must uphold the values of gender equality and women's empowerment.
- Must have demonstrated capacity in mobilizing people and resources for peacebuilding especially at the sub-regional level.
- Must have wide-ranging experience in advocating for systemic change relating to women's inclusion in conflict prevention, resolution, peacebuilding or security particularly at a sub-regional level.
- Must be willing to have information about their work used for advocacy purposes through the N-Peace network.
- Must be residing in the Asia-Pacific region at the time of being nominated.

#### **Criteria II.**

**Campaigning for Action – women and men mobilizing for peace at the sub-national levels (single award):** *This award recognizes the work of a woman or man whose mobilization and advocacy efforts have resulted in the advancement of women, peace and security issues particularly at the sub-national level.*

#### Eligibility

- Women and men from the Philippines, Afghanistan, Indonesia, Nepal, Myanmar, Pakistan or Sri Lanka are eligible.
- Must be aged 30 years or older and must not have previously won an N-Peace Award.
- Must uphold the values of gender equality and women's empowerment.
- Must have demonstrated capacity in mobilizing people and resources for peacebuilding especially at the sub-regional level.
- Must have wide-ranging experience in advocating for systemic change relating to women's inclusion in conflict prevention, resolution, peacebuilding or security particularly at a sub-regional level.
- The nominee could be a representative of a civil society, a public servant or a government official priority at the sub-national level. For example, the nominee could be a police officer who has sought and achieved national policy change on women and security, or a member of a district council who has consistently

advocated for the inclusion of women in peace processes and mobilized resources to implement this.

- Must be willing to have information about their work used for advocacy purposes through the N-Peace network.
- Must be residing in the Asia-Pacific region at the time of being nominated.

**Criteria III:**

**The Peace Generation – young women and men building peace through volunteerism (one woman and one man):** *This award recognizes the work of a young woman and a man who have demonstrated volunteerism as a powerful means of promoting social cohesion and reconciliation through engaging people. Their efforts in policy change, advocacy and mobilization, media communications, or community action have resulted in the advancement of women, peace and security issues.*

Eligibility:

- Women and men from the Philippines, Afghanistan, Indonesia, Nepal, Myanmar, or Pakistan Sri Lanka are eligible.
- Must be aged 25 years or younger at the time of nomination and must not have previously won an N-Peace Award.
- Must uphold the values of gender equality and women's empowerment.
