Instructions for completing the online application for training Program In Professions
Supplementary to Medicine and Paramedical Services.

Before completing the application, read the gazette notification and the instructions given to complete the online application.

The closing date for applications is 30-11-2020.

Documents and information that the applicant should have at the beginning of the application process:

All applicants should have the following documents / information –

National Identity Card

Height- should be expressed in (cm)

A working mobile phone number

Receipt obtained from the bank after making the payment

1. A mobile phone number must be entered. The applicant can also enter his or her father's or mother's mobile phone number.
2. The applicant should have a copy of the receipt obtained from the bank after making the payment of Rs. 500 /- at any branch of Bank of Ceylon to the account of the Director General of Health Services, Bank of Ceylon Taprobane Branch No. 7041318. The printed number of the receipt should be entered in the appropriate place in the application.

Steps in the application submission process

Online application → Secure the 5-digit code you receive after uploading the application for ease of obtaining hard copies later

N.B.

- If the application process is not completed due to internet interruption or any other reason, it should be completed again as a new application
 - If you are applying for more than one course, you should select those courses in order of priority according to your preference. Your preference order will **NOT** be allowed to change **under any circumstances** after submitting the application.
3. After submitting the complete application online, obtain a hard copy and keep it in your possession.
 4. Please do not send the application by post to the Ministry of Health.

Important points to consider when registering online

3. You need to complete the application only in English.
4. When registering online, the applicant should use the same National Identity Card number used in the GCE (A / L) examination.

Important points to consider when completing the application online

3. After entering the relevant examination numbers, the GCE (Advanced Level) examination results and GCE (O/L) examination results are generated automatically. However, if there are any discrepancies in the results, the result and the subject can be corrected on the following section.
