**for Development of Electronic Data Management System for the National  
Programme for Tuberculosis Control and Chest Diseases (NPTCCD)**

The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has received a grant from the Global Fund to fight AIDS, Tuberculosis & Malaria (GFATM) towards the cost of the Sri Lanka and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to payments under the contract for Consultancy on Developing Electronic Data Management System for which this Request for Proposal is invited.

The objective of the consultancy is to assist in further development (including additional modules development) for the existing District Health Information System (DHIS 2) based electronic Recording and Reporting System of the National Programme for Tuberculosis Control and Chest Diseases (NPTCCD), by developing an Electronic Data Management System under the GFATM Project.

The specific objectives of the Assignment are;

- To study the data elements, indicators and reports captured and generated in the ;
  - a) existing paper based system and
  - b) current electronic Recording and Reporting Systemused at the NPTCCD for aggregate and individual case recording and reporting.
- To identify the gaps and shortcomings of the current electronic Recording and Reporting System used at the NPTCCD aggregate and individual case recording and reporting.
- To design and develop the additional requirements to the System used at the NPTCCD with regards to aggregate and individual case recording and reporting.
- To design and develop;
  - a) Laboratory Information Management System Module

- b) Drug Stock Information Management System
- c) MDR Patient Recording and Reporting Module

to the existing electronic Recording and Reporting System used at the NPTCCD

- To provide user training to the relevant staff of NPTCCD and District Chest Clinics on using the Electronic Data Management System.
- To implement the new Electronic Data Management System, identify issues related and provide solutions.
- To develop a strategy to obtain continuous support for the Electronic Data Management System.
- To develop a strategy to interlink/integrate the developed system later with the National Health Information System and relevant other subsystems including national HIV Patient Information Databases.

  - f. Experience in health sector (Government/ Private) and similar geographical areas undertaken by the applicant.
  - g. Documentary evidence to indicate financial capability and financial soundness of the firm. Please attach last three years audited financial reports.



- h. Experience in working with the DHIS2 platform and other health information systems

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of Joint Ventures (JV) under above requirements to enhance their qualifications and need to be indicated details of such 'JV' particulars. However, the Consultant shall not subcontract any part of the Assignment.
