Terms of Reference

Consultancy for development of software requirements specification document (SRS) for know4sure.lk software upgrading

Introduction

NSACP maintains an online outreaching web-based platform for key populations in Sri Lanka by named know4sure.lk. This online system provides a platform for users of the Key populations in Sri Lanka to anonymously assess their risk for HIV and STIs.

NSACP has the vision to provide all essential HIV services to users through this site considering the cost-effectiveness and COVID-19 related issues. These new services include ordering and delivering health products (condoms and lubricants) and ordering and delivering HIV self-test kits

However, at present know4sure.lk can provide only the following services

- Risk assessment for HIV and STIs.
- Contact online outreach workers who can support individual users.
- Booking of an appointment for HIV and STI services including provision of PrEP.

All services are provided free charge in public STD clinics. The website shows a list of these clinics that are nearest to the user, asks there to choose a convenient time, then collects a few more pieces of information to plan their reservation – and then completes the reservation.

Scope/Objective

1. To analyze workflow requirements, develop SRS (Software Requirements Specification) document based on the existing application considered as a prototype.
2. Provide technical support for software development during the design and implementation phase, development of the know4sure user manual.

Tasks

1. Gather new requirements for software upgradation by consultation of relevant NSACP programme coordinators such as HIV testing coordinator, HIV ST coordinator, KP coordinator Online KP coordinator, SIM coordinator and online outreach workers.
2. Prepare the Requirements Specification document to upgrade the existing know4Sure.lk web application.
3. Prepare a TOR (terms of reference) to procure a suitable software agency to upgrade the existing know4sure web application.
4. Provide technical direction to software developers based on the SRS during the software development phase.
