



## **INVITATION FOR BIDS**

**THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA**

**CONSTRUCTION OF NEW MATERNITY HOSPITAL GALLE, SRI LANKA**

**SUPPLY, INSTALLATION, TESTING AND COMMISSIONING, USER TRAINING AND MAINTENANCE OF NON-MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND FURNITURE.**

**Contract No: MHG/NMEQFUR/2019 - BMZ Nr. 2011 66 206 - 2**

1. The Government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka through its Ministry of Health (MoH) has received a loan from the Government of Federal Republic of Germany through Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau (KfW), Development Bank towards the cost of the construction of the new Maternity Hospital Galle (BMZ no. 2011 66 2016 -1), including procurement of Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning, User Training and Maintenance of Non-Medical Equipment and Furniture. It is intended to apply part of the budget to subsidize supply of goods and these Works. Payments under this contract will be affected by KfW Bank directly to the contractor.
2. Funds have been committed for this project by the German Government through KfW development bank. (Financial Corporation, FC)
3. MoH now invites the sealed bids from eligible bidders; International and Sri Lankan registered suppliers and voluntary formed joint ventures providing the necessary licenses applicable and in accordance with the legislation of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka on licensing as well as necessary certificates for Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning, User Training and Maintenance of Non-Medical Equipment and Furniture. The time for the works will be 120 Calendar days.
4. Bidding will be conducted on the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) basis given in the bid document for Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning, User Training and Maintenance of Non-Medical Equipment and Furniture. This Standard Bidding Document (“SBD”) for Procurement of Goods has been prepared by KfW Development Bank (“KfW”) and is based on the harmonized Master Procurement Document “Standard Bidding Documents for Procurement of Goods and User’s Guide” developed by the participating Multilateral Development Banks and International Financing Institutions, which represents the best practices of these institutions. The SBD published website refers as “FZ-Vergabemanagement@kfw.de”.

5. The formal responsibility for the implementation of the project lies with the MoH as project executing agency (PEA) for the design and implementation and conclusion of the contract and the supervision of the work, its acceptance and the monitoring of defect notification period, the consultant GITEC-IGIP GmbH is representing the PEA (Consulting Contract).
6. The scope of work consists of Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning, User Training and Maintenance of Non-Medical Equipment and Furniture. The Bidders shall make themselves familiar with the conditions on the Site and submit proposals for the Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning, User Training and Maintenance of Non-Medical Equipment and Furniture, technically responsive to the BoQs and Specification as per Annex 1 for Lot 7 Mortuary and Health Care Waste Management Equipment, Annex 2 for Lot 8 CSSD, Laundry and Kitchen Equipment, Annex 3 for Lot 9 Non-Medical Furniture.
7. The minimum requirement for Post qualification will be to have successfully carried out a minimum of one (01) similar contracts of a minimum value of EUR 450,000.00 for Lot 7 Mortuary and Health Care Waste Management Equipment, EUR 1,100,000.00 for Lot 8 CSSD, Laundry and Kitchen Equipment and EUR 880,000.00 for Lot 9 Non-Medical Furniture, that have been satisfactorily and substantially completed as Supplier, or joint venture member during the past ten (10) years.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security, please find below the Bid Securities per lot. interested bidders intending to participate in different lots, shall provide one separate Bid Security per lot, with the following amounts EUR 9,000.00 for Lot 7 Mortuary and Health Care Waste Management Equipment, EUR 22,000.00 for Lot 8 CSSD, Laundry and Kitchen Equipment and EUR 18,000.00 for Lot 9 Non-Medical Furniture.
