Eligibility:

Applications are invited from Medical officers /Mental Health/ Psychiatry, Community Psychiatry Nurses, Occupational Therapist /Mental health, Psychiatric Social Workers, Development Officers /Mental Health.

Participants seeking to attend the training programme must meet all of the following criteria to be considered for selection.

1. Have sufficient English language skills
2. Have a good health condition
3. Working in institutions under the Ministry of Health, Nutrition and Indigenous Medicine or Provincial Councils
4. Involve in strengthening of community mental health programme at either national or district level

Working Language of the Training: The Training Program will be in full English without interpreter. Training consists of lectures, group discussions, presentations, case studies, site visits and writing project proposals.

The Department of Mental Health, Thailand will provide the accommodation, meals and local transportation during the training programme.
