Collaborative Training Initiative (CITI) programme

National Science Foundation (NSF), Sri Lanka in collaboration with the University of Miami, USA is pleased to introduce the Collaborative Training Initiative (CITI) programme for Sri Lankan researchers and Ethics Review Committee members. The CITI programme is a web based educational programme that has trained more than 10 million researchers across the globe, including members of Research Ethics Committees, students and academic staff, on principles of Research Ethics and Scientific Integrity; Good Clinical Practices and the Welfare of Laboratory Animals.

NSF has paid the annual subscription fee of USD 3,000 to make this programme available for Sri Lankan Scientific Community. The courses are offered completely free of charge to researchers and Ethics Review Committee members in Sri Lankan institutions. Currently there are about three hundred applicants following courses under the NSF -CITI Portal.
