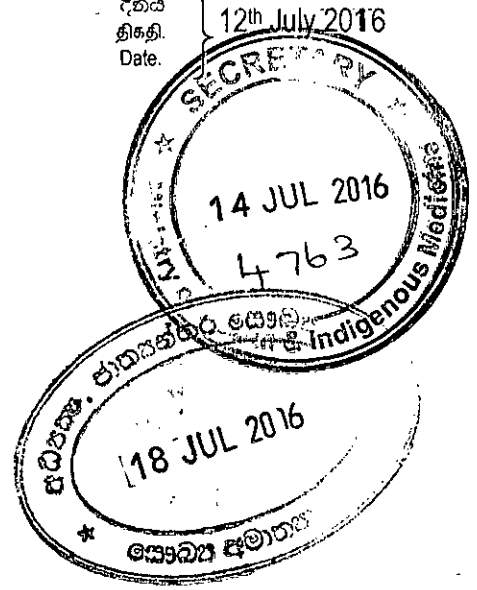

The Commonwealth Secretariat has informed us that the Government of India has allocated 30 places for participants of Commonwealth Member States under the India Technical Economic Cooperation (ITEC) Programme 2016-2017.

All eligible applicants are now requested to fill their applications at the "[Apply for ITEC/SCAAP course](https://www.itecgoi.in/meaportal/registerApplicant)" link at the ITEC website (<https://www.itecgoi.in/meaportal/registerApplicant>).

Administrative Officers could apply for the IT, English Courses and Management Courses, if they have Academic qualifications met with the required qualification laid down by the institute and 5 years working experience in the same position.

The hard copies (02 sets) of the applications should be submitted to the Department of External Resources along with the recommendation of the Ministry and the following documents at least four months before the commencement of the course.



The guidelines, Course details, terms and conditions of ITEC/SCAPP, list of approved panel of hospitals could be downloaded from www.erd.gov.lk. The relevant Ministries should take necessary step to inform the department and institute which comes under the purview of the Ministry.

If a candidate has already attended a course sponsored by Government of India, he/she is not eligible for ITEC courses.
