Background of the project

Sri Lanka was targeting to achieve a 2/3 reduction in maternal mortality ratio in Millennium Development Goals (MDG) by 2015. In 2014, the country reported a MMR of 32.03 per 100000 live births. However, it is important to know the actual situation with regard to maternal deaths in the index year. Therefore, an analysis of reproductive aged female deaths (RAFD) and their causes will provide an insight into the maternal deaths and whether present maternal death surveillance & response (MDSR) system captures all maternal deaths. A profile of RAFD is at present not available.

Various data sources exist in Sri Lanka to obtain reproductive aged female deaths (RAFD); Registrar General's Department (RGD), hospital mortality data (based on Indoor Morbidity & Mortality Register - IMMR) and MDSR system of Family Health Bureau.

Scope of the work :

Under the supervision of National Program Manager (Maternal & Child Morbidity & Mortality Surveillance Unit of FHB), Pre-Intern Medical officers will perform the following;

1. To collect identified variables on reproductive aged group female deaths in Sri Lanka from different data sources
2. To collate and compile all the reproductive aged group female deaths data received to MCMMS unit
3. To enter collected data in to a database
4. To assist NPM in analyzing the reproductive aged group female deaths data
5. To assist NPM in documentation/preparing reports based on reproductive aged group female deaths data
6. Any other activities arranged by the National Program Manager or Director/MCH

Selected pre-intern medical officers will be posted to MCMMS unit of Family Health Bureau
