The Chronic Kidney disease of uncertain etiology prevalent in the North Central region of Sri Lanka is due to an environmental/geological nephrotoxin causing slowly progressive chronic fibrosis of kidneys in susceptible population of the region.

A team of researchers from Faculty of Medicine, University of Peradeniya and the Renal Unit General Hospital Kandy have been investigating the CKD prevalent in North Central Area.

The National Health Development Fund of the Ministry of Healthcare and Nutrition is funding for this project and the following positions have been created and application are invited from citizen of Sri Lanka.
