Capacity Building Activity for **Enhancement of Nursing Education and Training Program** 26 to 28 March 2024, Republic of Korea - Request for Nominations

The Asian Development Bank (ADB), in collaboration with the Inje University, is pleased to inform you that a workshop and study visit on "Capacity Building Activity for ADB DMCs for Enhancement of Nursing Education and Training Program" will be held in Seoul, Republic of Korea from 25 to 29 March 2024.

These capacity building activities aim to assist nursing colleges in improving the quality of nursing education and training, and to promote cross-border university collaboration that offers mutually beneficial opportunities for higher education in ADB developing member countries (DMC) including the Philippines, Vietnam, Lao PDR, Bangladesh, and Sri Lanka.

- (ii) Nursing education system with nursing curriculum focus on bachelor's degree
- (iii) Teaching and research capacity of nursing educators
- (iv) Accreditation standards for nursing education institutions
- (v) Conduction of National Licensure Examination for Nurses
- (vi) Needs Assessment of innovative higher nursing education through nurse educators

This also aims to promote cross-border university collaboration that offers mutually beneficial opportunities for higher education in including Philippines, India, Lao PDR, Bangladesh, and Sri Lanka.
