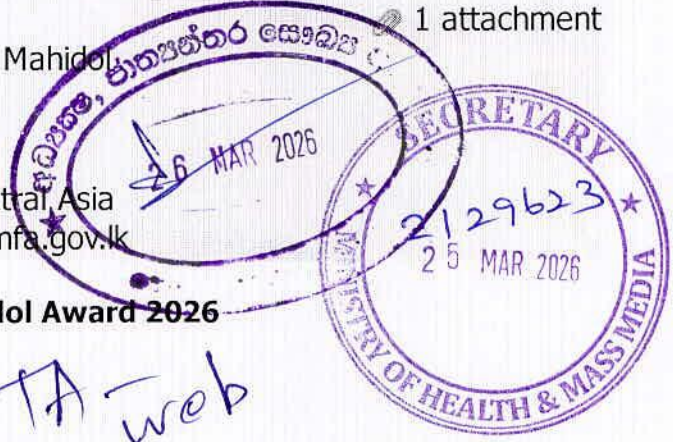

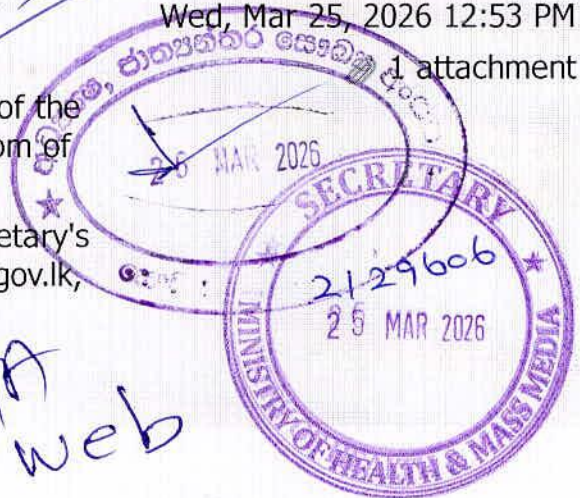

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to all Diplomatic and Consular missions in Bangkok and has the honour to inform the latter of the invitation for nomination of the Prince Mahidol Award 2026 on the Occasion of the 135th Anniversary of the Birthday of His Royal Highness Prince Mahidol of Songkla. The Prince Mahidol Award Foundation of Thailand was established on 1 January 1992 in commemoration of the centenary of the birth of His Royal Highness. The Foundation is under the Royal Patronage, with Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn as President.

The Award is conferred annually on individuals or institutions that have demonstrated outstanding performances and/or conducted research that contributes to the advancement of medical and public health services, as well as to the betterment of society. The Award is divided into two categories: Medicine and Public Health. The prize of each Award consists of a medal, a certificate, and USD 100,000. An individual, a group of individuals, or an institution may be nominated by national medical or health authorities, or by an individual or group of individuals in non-governmental capacities, from now until the nomination process closes on 31 May 2026 at 23.59 hours.

The Ministry has further the honour to request all Diplomatic and Consular missions' kind assistance and cooperation in informing the respective concerned agencies within the latter's countries of the invitation for nomination of the Prince Mahidol Award 2026, as well as in encouraging them to submit appropriate nominations.
