

Research Methodology Training for Medical Officers

Introduction

Research is an essential component for improvement of any work environment and service delivery particularly in the health sector. Medical Officers should have updated with evidence-based management to deliver better health care. This program will upgrade the knowledge and skills in research methods; giving opportunity to attend the program with minimum disturbance to the routing activities.

Teaching Methods

The research training program will be delivered as a blended programme with the distance online training. One compulsory workshop and three optional workshops will be delivered in Colombo. Hands on skills will be developed during the contact workshops which will essential for research training. These workshops include essential components for hands on skill development sessions. There are eleven Modules to be completed with referring to online materials. Participants are expected to spend over 4 – 6 hours per week for studying each lesson.

Basic requirements to follow the training program

The program will be opened for Medical Officers and the specialist medical officers, Ministry of Health (free of charge). The program will be delivered in English medium. The program includes the compulsory workshop, optional workshops (Approximately one workshop for a month), online modules and the post test. Those who complete all the components of the program will be given the certificate. Since the participants need to access the online lessons, availability of internet and a personnel computers/laptop/tablet is essential. Skills in handling the computer is an added advantage.
